Media Accepted

Painting (all media), Mixed Media, Drawing, Printmaking, Photography, Studio Ceramics, Small Sculpture, Metalsmithing, Fiber Art and Video Art (but not documentary films).

The work must be original, created within the last three (3) years, and must be available for exhibition if selected. One or two artworks may be submitted.

Exceptions

- No 3-D work over 50" x 50" x 50"
- No work on paper over 50" in any one direction, including frame.
- No work the gallery deems fragile, subject to damage, or requiring gallery supervision during open hours.

Size and installation restrictions may apply for 3-D submissions that include installation and maintenance.

Framing

All framed work should have wire hangers securely attached with screws, NOT thumbtacks or staples or duct tape. All unframed work must be accompanied by the hardware needed to install it.

WORK NOT PROPERLY PREPARED FOR EXHIBITION WILL BE REJECTED BY GALLERY DIRECTOR UPON DELIVERY & RECONSIDERED ONLY IF SATISFACTORY CHANGES ARE MADE.

Exhibition Requirements

Artists whose works are selected for the 2015 exhibition are invited to participate in the Showcase of the Arts on Sunday, May 3, 2015 at 2:00 pm, at the Ivy Tech John Waldron Arts Center in Bloomington, IN.

Sale of Art Work

Artists must provide the value of their work, but if the artwork is not for sale, indicate that it is NFS (not for sale). The NSAL and Ivy Tech Waldron do NOT take sales commissions.

Submission Requirements

All art submitted for judging must be the actual work to be in the exhibition and with the exception of video art, must be provided as a digital image on a disk or email attachment (not more than 2MB).

Video art must be submitted on a flash drive or as a VIMEO link; length is not to exceed 5 minutes. Artists may need to provide equipment to play video art in the gallery.

Materials will be returned only if a self-addressed envelope or package with sufficient postage attached is provided.

Application Form Deadline

All entrants must submit an application form along with their CD, flash drive, or digital files by **November 7, 2014.**

Artworks delivered for the show must be identified with the name of the artist and title.

NO ENTRY FEE IS REQUIRED.

Liability

Art work is not insured by NSAL, and the NSAL is not liable for damage or loss of art work. Art that requires repair due to technical failures during run of exhibit will be removed from display until artist can make repairs. Staff will not alter or amend the art in any way, per insurance guidelines.
