BASIC SEARCH SKILLS (WHERE & HOW TO SEARCH)



Basic orientation to library & website
Intro to multidisciplinary academic search tools
Search techniques (keywords/limiters/etc)

Aligns with Bulletin:

EVALUATION (TYPES OF SOURCES & CRITICAL SELECTION)



CRAAP test for evaluation of all information sources
Appropriateness
Specific criteria as related to assignment:
Popular v. scholarly
Primary v. secondary

USING SOURCES (CITATION & PLAGIARISM)



Using sources to support claims
Citation - what is is, how to do it, why it matters
Plagiarism
