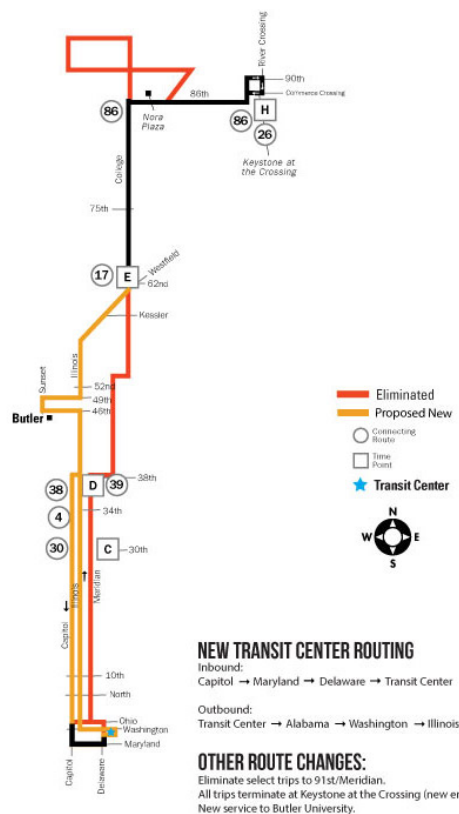


## Instruction Form for Staff to Provide Input on IndyGo Forward Plans

**Step 1:** Navigate to: <http://www.indygo.net/news/indygo-forward/>

**Step 2:** Learn more about IndyGo Forward plans to change the next 5 years of transit in Indianapolis

- Explore the proposed change for Route #18 which would create a new service line to Butler University
  - Inbound: Capitol > Maryland > Delaware > Transit Center
  - Outbound: Transit Center > Alabama > Washington > Illinois
  - Other route Changes:
    - Eliminate select trips to 91<sup>st</sup>/Meridian.
    - All trips terminate at Keystone at the Crossing (new end of line).
    - New service to Butler University.



**Step 3:** Voice your opinions and wants from the proposed Route 18 which would have service to campus.

- Under the sub-heading at the top of the page titled: “Give Your Input”, click the link. The link can also be accessed by selecting here: <http://www.indygo.net/contact-us/online-comment-form/>
  - Clicking the link will pull-up an online form which you will now fill-out.

**Step 4:** Complete the form to voice your opinion to IndyGo. Please follow the directions as listed below.

  - IndyGo Forward Proposed Route 18 to Butler University
- “Please enter the date pertaining to your comment:”
